Named Gift Opportunities

In addition to gifts and bequests to the campaign's objectives, donors may attach their names to or memorialize someone through a named fund for a physical element. All those who support the Village Congregational Church's capital campaign with a named gift will be listed on a special recognition plaque to be displayed inside the side entrance.

Naming opportunities through gifts and bequests are available for the following entities:

Exterior Restorations:

- Restoration of Bell Tower - \$ 100,000
- Parking area \$ 75,000
- Landscaping - \$ 50,000
- Portico entrance steps \$ 15,000

Interior Renovations:

- Handicapped ramp \$ 150,000
- Elevator \$ 100,000
- Kitchen * \$ 150,000
- Stained glass restoration \$ 75,000
- Class Room # 1 * \$ 75,000
- Class Room # 2 * \$ 75,000
- Sprinkler update \$ 50,000
- Nursery * \$ 50,000
- Barrier-free bathroom (4) \$ 25,000 (per bathroom)
- Technology Improvements
 - New security system \$ 25,000
 - Hymnal display/screen system \$ 15,000
 - Sanctuary sound system \$ 10,000
 - Audio/video recording system \$ 10,000

Note * several opportunities within the kitchen renovation priorities are available for individual naming. Similar opportunities exist in the classrooms and nursery. There are a number of opportunities for donors to participate collectively in naming various projects or programs.

Endowed Gifts:

There are a number of opportunities to name special funds for outreach, Christian Education and other mission initiatives. Named endowed funds range from \$5,000 to \$100,000. Endowed funds are invested with Salem Capital Management. Over the past decade, the return on investment has exceeded 11% net of fees. Normally all endowment funds are commingled with the Church's existing investment fund.
